



WHY CAN'T I SEE THE PROFESSOR IN THE RECORDING? WHY IS THE PROFESSOR SO SMALL IN THE RECORDING?

Zoom Webinar has limited viewing options for recordings. The options depend on the device you are using (computer or iPad or casting from a phone to your television). The biggest decision you must make is whether to watch in Full Screen mode.

The default mode looks like this:
