

## HOW TO FIND YOUR LINK AND WATCH A <u>RECORDING</u> OF AN ALUMNAE COURSE

**1.** Open the email associated with your NBO account and course enrollment. If you maintain more than one email address, check <u>all</u> of them.

2A. Scroll down to find emails by date.

2B. <u>or</u> Filter your email by typing "Alumnae of NU" in the search bar and hit the enter or return key.

(This allows you to only see the recordings that were sent to you each week without having to scroll through hundreds of other emails.)
